1. An elector whose application to vote by post has been granted is disqualified from voting in person at the polling station on election day.

An application by a person wishing to register to vote by post must be made before noon on Thursday, 21st February, 2019, and the sealed envelope containing the completed ballot papers and other documentation must be returned to the Judicial Greffe by no later than noon on Wednesday 27th February, 2019, in order for the vote to be included in the count.
